

## **Ruby on Rails**

Ruby on Rails is an open source full-stack web application framework for the Ruby programming language. It gives the web developer the ability to gather information from the web server, talk to or query the database, and render templates out of the box. As a result, Rails features a routing system that is independent of the web server.
